## Meet City Council

The Cleburne City Council supervises city operations and implements policies adopted by the council. The council consists of four single-member district seats and a mayor.

In the single-member district system, each area elects its own representative. The mayor, however, is elected by all residents eligible to vote.

Cleburne has a council-manager system of government. Under this system, an elected council makes policy and passes ordinances, and the city manager

Council members serve two-year terms. The council meets at 5 p.m. the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at Cleburne City Hall, 10 N. Robinson St. The city hall building anchoring the east end of downtown, formerly housed a post office. The public is encouraged to attend council meetings. 
Pay your city utility the easy way by bank draft, there is no fee for this service. No monthly checks to write; save on postage costs; it's convenient, fast and easy; and

The award represents a significant achievement for the entity. It reflects the commitment of the governing body and staff to meeting the highest principles of governmental budgeting. In order to receive the budget award, the entity had to satisfy nationally recognized guidelines for effective budget presentation. These guidelines are de-

signed to assess how well an entity's budget serves as:

- a policy document
- a financial plan
- an operations guide
- a communication device

Budget documents must be rated "proficient" in all for categories, and the fourteen mandatory criteria within those categories, to receive the award.


When a Distinguished Budget Presentation Award is granted to an entity, a Certificate of Recognition for Budget Presentation is also presented

to the individual or department designed as being primarily responsible for its having achieved the award. This has been presented to Terry Leake, Director of Finance.

For budgets beginning in 2014, 1,491 participants received the Award. Award recipients have pioneered efforts to improve the quality of budgeting and provide an excellent example for other governments throughout North America.

provincial-level government officials and other finance practitioners. 


Local entertainment, Southwest Reprise Theatre, performing at Trinity Cumberland Presbyterian Church will present:




