Meet City Council

The Cleburne City Council consists of four single-member district seats and a mayor.

In the single-member district system, each area elects its own representative. The mayor, however, is elected by all residents eligible to vote.

Cleburne has a council-manager system of government. Under this system, an elected council makes policy and passes ordinances, and the city manager supervises city opera-

tions and implements policies adopted by the council.

Council members serve two-year terms. The council meets at 5 p.m. the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at Cleburne City Hall, 10 N. Robinson St. The city hall building anchoring the east end of downtown, formerly housed a post office. The public is encouraged to attend council meetings. 
To ensure the safety of residents and the construction workers, portions of South Nolan River Rd. will be closed to through traffic intermittently during the duration of the projects.

The City of Cleburne will be starting construction projects affecting Nolan River Road beginning August 17th and lasting for 9-12 months. The construction work will consist of installing a water line that will delineate the boundary between the upper and lower pressure planes for the drinking water system. The water line will be installed from Surry Place Dr. to Henderson St.

Once the water line installation is complete, Nolan River Road will be reconstructed and repaved. The

new road will consist of 8 inches of treated subgrade and 8 inches of asphalt. This is significantly more robust than the existing roadway and we expect that major road construction on South Nolan River Rd. will not be necessary for many years.

To complete the project, the city with funding participation from TxDOT, will construct five foot wide sidewalks along Nolan River Rd. The sidewalk project will begin at Harlin Dr. near the high school and will end at Country Club Rd. near Lowell Smith Middle School.

Safety is of utmost importance during the construction process. To ensure the safety of residents and the construction workers, portions of South Nolan River Rd. will be closed to through traffic intermittently during the duration of the projects. Detours and alternate routes will be clearly marked with construction signage. The contractors will work with individuals living on Nolan River Rd. to ensure access is maintained to their property.

We recognize the inconvenience that will be encounter due to the construction project. We appreciate your continued patience as we work to improve the infrastructure throughout the city. The City will





4th Annual North Texas Safety & Preparedness Fair

Mock Pipeline Rupture Exercise

The North Texas Damage Prevention Council invites you to participate in the 4th Annual North Texas Safety & Preparedness Fair to network with municipal/county emergency officials and utility/pipeline personnel from across North Texas.

Pipeline Rupture Exercise Overview

When excavation activities cause damage to a gas pipeline, there is an immediate impact to employee and public safety as natural gas escapes into the atmosphere. The North Texas Damage Prevention Council invites you observe a pipeline safety demonstration which emphasizes proper use of the 811 notification system, how to safely excavate in the vicinity of a gas pipeline, and what specific actions a person should take in the unfortunate event that a pipeline is ruptured.

Participants will have the rare opportunity to see and hear what it is like when a backhoe ruptures a gas pipeline. Observe a pipeline locating demonstration conducted by industry professionals, witness the roar of the gas release* and blowing dirt when a backhoe punctures the pipe, feel the adrenaline rush of arriving emergency responders, and finally, a helicopter rescue of a "man down".

* For safety during this demonstration, the pipeline will be filled with compressed air instead of natural gas.
