Meet City Council

The Cleburne City Council consists of four single-member district seats and a mayor.


In the single-member district system, each area elects its own representative. The mayor, however, is elected by all residents eligible to vote.

Cleburne has a council-manager system of government. Under this system, an elected council makes policy and passes ordinances, and the city manager supervises city opera-

tions and implements policies adopted by the council.

Council members serve two-year terms. The council meets at 5 p.m. the second and fourth Tuesday of each month at Cleburne City Hall, 10 N. Robinson St. The city hall building anchoring the east end of downtown, formerly housed a post office. The public is encouraged to attend council meetings. The new rate for non-Cleburne residents and businesses for a pick-up sized load of 800 lbs or less will be \$20.00.

See details for the new drop-off rates for Transfer Station

On January 1, 2017, new fees will be in effect at the Transfer Station, as the current rates for drop-offs have been in effect since 2000. Cleburne residents and businesses will pay a lower per ton rate (\$42.00) than non-Cleburne residents (\$55.00) for all drop-offs from a large truck or trailer with a one ton minimum charged. There will be no change for Cleburne residents and businesses to the current rate of \$15.00 for a pick-up sized load of 800 lbs or less brought to the Transfer Station. The new rate for

non-Cleburne residents and businesses for a pick-up sized load of 800 lbs or less will be \$20.00. Also, there is no change in the current rates for any tire drop-offs. Proof of residency will be a City water bill.

Benefits of the Transfer Station:

Low-Price—Even with a price increase, we still offer a much lower minimum and our rates will continue to be somewhat competitive.

Courtesy—no one really likes dumping trash. So we try to give our customers the very best service we can, by being friendly, informative and efficient. While communication isn't everything, it is really important for the benefit and safety of those using the facility. In addition, we have the most handsome man we can find operating the Scale House, greeting everyone and mesmerizing some.

Consistency—while other dumping facilities sometimes vary in the way they charge for loads, we are consistent in our prices. We charge all trucks by the load and all trailers by weight.

Convenient location—not only is the CTS central to Johnson County, we are

just a mile from Texas Highway 174 three quarters of a mile from US 67.

Easy to use—while you drive in muddy or dusty lanes at a landfill, you stay on pavement when dumping here. Unless you have limbs. Then it's a short drive over mulch to the limb pile. Also, everything is in a concise area, and there is very little separating to do.

Full service—we take nearly everything. Except for dangerous or hazardous waste, we take everything you need to throw away, from trash and limbs to recycle and tires. And it is all in one facility.

Time-saving—unless it is during our peak times, loads are often weighed in, dumped and weighed out in just a few minutes. During peak times, we try to enable our customers to unload their trash as quickly as possible and try to accommodate everyone in their time and efforts. ■






